Under the Biden-Harris Administration, thousands of people in the Northern Mariana Islands stand to benefit from the President's actions to invest in clean energy, infrastructure, and manufacturing as well as lower health care, energy, and education costs.

The Biden-Harris Administration has made historic investments to improve Northern Mariana Islands's infrastructure and build a clean energy economy, including:

- ★ Saipan Harbor Navigation Enhancements: The U.S. Department of Transportation awarded the Commonwealth Port Authority a \$3.1 million Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) grant to support planning work for navigation improvements at Saipan Harbor.
- ★ Kagman Watershed Resiliency Enhancements: The U.S. Department of Agriculture awarded \$21 million to strengthen safeguards against flooding,

- enhance irrigation infrastructure, and secure marine habitats in the Kagman watershed.
- **★ Saipan International Airport Improvements**: The U.S. Department of Transportation awarded over \$7.6 million to Francisco C. Ada/Saipan International Airport to improve the airport's facilities.
- ★ Route 310 Mount Tapochao Road Safety Improvements: The Department of Transportation awarded \$12 million to the CNMI Department of Public Works to pave and widen the gravel Route 310 Mount Tapochao Road to allow vehicles traveling in opposite directions to safely pass each other.
- **★** Tinian International Airport: The Department of Transportation awarded over \$1 million to Tinian International Airport to improve the airport's facilities. This flexible funding can support projects modernize terminal infrastructure, improve safety, or address maintenance needs.
- ★ <u>Territorial Highway Program</u>: The Northern Mariana Islands is part of the \$239 million Territorial highway program that will support the construction and improvement of a system of arterial and collector highways and necessary inter-island connectors.
- **★** Agritourism Workforce Development: Northern Mariana College will receive \$10 million in funding to deliver a holistic agritourism workforce development framework.
